## Schools Triathlon Challenge (STC)

### Traffic Flow Plan

1. Please note this Traffic Management Plan was revised and a new Traffic flow was established for buses in 2017 and will continue in 2018.
2. Buses may no longer enter Queen Street or travel up Derwent Street.
3. ALL buses must now travel down Derwent Street and exit via Park Street.

The following notes are to be used in conjunction with the attached traffic flow map to help streamline traffic flow at the Hobart Schools Triathlon Challenge being held at Bellerive Beach on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2018 (Secondary / Colleges) and Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2018 (Primary Schools).

Please note:

- a. It is advised that to get to Bellerive Beach to avoid traffic congestion that all traffic coming off the Tasman Bridge should follow the Tasman Highway, take the slip lane to South Arm Highway and follow until the Shoreline Round about and then turn right onto Clarence Street and follow to Bellerive Cricket Ground.
- b. The same route should be followed in reverse to exit the STC event site at Bellerive.
- c. Please Note that the below on site traffic flow plan is for use with the map:
  - Buses are shown in Red
  - Bus layover area is shown in Pink
  - All other Traffic is shown in Blue
  - No Traffic Zone is shown in Green

### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### Buses: Drop off

1. Please approach via Scott, Derwent or Beach Street and head down Derwent Street (crossing Church Street) to drop off students on the left hand side of Derwent Street (the side closest to Blundstone Arena). This will be managed by traffic controllers, (Please offload students as quickly as possible and move on).

2. Once you have dropped students off please continue down Derwent Street and turn right into Park Street to exit.

3. If buses are parking for the day, then a new layover area for buses only will be made available in Church Street and the South Street Reserve / dog park area.

#### **Bus Layover in Church Street or South Street**

- Facing towards Derwent Street, using the left hand side of Church Street between Scott Street and Derwent Street.
- Facing towards Derwent Street, using the left hand side of Church Street between Beach Street and Derwent Street.
- South Street – buses may be parked in South Street or in the dog training area adjacent to South Street.

#### **Buses: Collection**

1. All buses must move down Derwent Street from Church Street to collect students at the end of the day and then exit via Park Street.
2. Drivers please give your mobile phone number to the organising teacher of the school you have transported.
3. School organising teachers will call bus drivers when they are ready to be collected in Derwent Street.
4. Buses will then pull out from where they are parked and move past other parked buses to drop off / collection point in Derwent Street.
5. Exit following the same route as your drop off instructions.

#### **All Private Vehicles:**

1. Approach down Queen Street or Scott Street.
2. You will be detoured across Queen Street at the Scott Street intersection.
3. After crossing Queen Street take the first left down Chapman Street, follow to the bottom.
4. Turn Left onto Victoria Esplanade (be aware of runners / part road closure in place here)
5. Collect your child or find a park on the left hand side of Queen Street to load bikes and move on as quickly as possible to help avoid congestion at the intersection.
- 6. Parking in Queen Street is only for collection of bikes, No long term parking will be available.**
